

Thank you for purchasing Don Salvatore's Havana Cigar Cafe, #1480!



GETTING STARTED

- After removing the Havana Cigar Cafe from the packaging open the top drawer. You may notice the dividers are slightly angled and not straight. Simply straighten the dividers. They tend to loosen from shipping.

****Due to the hand craftsmanship of each piece there may be slight variations in finish and color.**

- Next open the door of the unit. You will notice cardboard packaging holding the shelves in place. Remove all cardboard.

****You'll also notice a black rubber seal surrounding the inside area where the door closes. DO NOT remove the seal! This seal ensures that your Havana Cigar Cafe is tightly closed to keep your cigars fresh! (Refer to diagram A)**

- Your units drawer and door are fitted from the factory. If need be you can adjust the European hinges for a perfect fit! (Refer to diagram B)

- Leveling guides are on the bottom of the unit and can be adjusted for uneven floors.

- To remove the shelves simply pick up the shelf off of the pegs and angle it down. Slowly pull out so as not to damage the sides of the unit or the shelves themselves. (Refer to diagram C)
- To remove the wine bottle dividers simply pull the front and back dividers out of the shelf. You'll quickly notice that the wine dividers have pegs and the shelves have the holes that they easily fit into. (Refer to diagram D)

****Your Havana Cigar Cafe is designed to store 16 twenty-five capacity cigar boxes with all of the trays removed or up to 8 wine bottles with both shelves in. You can customize your unit to fit your needs!**

- Keys are located in the white accessory box along with additional humistats. When locking your unit you may need to push the drawer or door in or pull out slightly to lock properly. Each unit is handmade so try both ways to determine which works best for you!

****The supplemental humidification devices you're supplied with may be used if you live in an extremely dry area. Normally the Cigar Oasis Plus should be more than enough to keep your cigars fresh!**

PREPARING YOUR HUMIDIFICATION SYSTEM

- It is necessary to calibrate your Dial Style (Analog) hygrometer before use to maintain the proper humidity level. It is easy to do! Simply remove the hygrometer and wrap it in a wet cloth for 30 - 40 minutes. Remove the hygrometer from the wet cloth and readjust the hygrometer through the back with a screwdriver and turn it so that it reads 100%. Then place the hygrometer in the humidor.

- Each unit comes with the Cigar Oasis Plus Humidification system. You'll notice on the inside

bottom right corner of the unit is a white perforated seal. Plug the adapter for the Cigar Oasis Plus into an outlet. Then from the back of the unit push the small connector through the white perforated seal and plug it into the Cigar Oasis Plus inside the humidor. **(Refer to diagrams E & F)** Be sure to thoroughly read the operating instructions for the Cigar Oasis Plus which are located with the unit.

- Normally you do not need to season your humidor since the Cigar Oasis Plus humistat is included. However, if you are in an extremely dry area and you do wish to season your humidor, simply follow the seasoning instructions below:

Seasoning Your Don Salvatore Humidor

To season your humidor, take a new sponge - make sure it is unscented and free of soap - and wet it with a liberal dose of distilled water. Wipe down all the exposed wood, including dividers, and the interior lid. Avoid using a paper towel or a fraying cloth; these will literally leave a paper trail on the wood. After you've wiped down the wood, squirt the sponge with more distilled water, then place it inside the humidor on a plastic bag - to avoid direct contact with the wood - and close the lid.

Next, you need to prepare your humidification device. Follow the instructions that are included with the Cigar Oasis Plus Humistat.

Close the humidor with its humidifying element and the damp sponge, and leave it overnight. The next day, refresh the humidification device (it may not need it) and check the sponge. If it is fairly dry, add more distilled water. If it is very damp, leave it alone.

Let the humidor sit another night, and then remove the sponge and plastic bag. The walls of the humidor have now absorbed all the water they need, and now you can safely store your cigars.

SPECIAL CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- ****When placing your Havana Cigar Cafe in your home or office be sure to keep it away from direct sunlight and heating vents as excess heat will affect the storage of cigars****
- As with all fine wood furniture, simply dust your Don Salvatore Humidor regularly with a clean, soft cloth. You can use a glass cleaner on the glass door and drawer to remove fingerprints or smudges. No liquid or spray dusting or waxing product is necessary. However, if you do elect to use such products, follow all manufacturer's directions very carefully. Make sure to avoid getting any such product into the interior of your humidor.
